Immersion dyeing is a process where colors are blended into fabric as seen on the label created by our own Kelly Austin. Our Immersion blend is meant to marry the flavors of Rhone varieties grown in and around our estate Grosgrain Vineyard, located on a basalt ridge in the southern reaches of the Walla Walla Valley. Aged 11 months in neutral French oak.

Deep ruby and structured with refreshing acidity, firm youthful tannins, and aromas of blackcurrant, sage and flint.
